Audition Forms for Aladdin

Practice will be after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays through May from 2:40 to 3:45. In April and May they may last one and ½ hours. Do not audition if you cannot make rehearsals! All students will not come every week. A rehearsal schedule will be posted on my webpage. On the days when we are rehearsing a scene your child is not in they should not come. It is important that I have your email for updates and changes.

Auditions will be in the Multi-Use room on:

Tuesday January 17th from 2:45 till we're done. You may leave after your audition. (If you can't make it for a good reason, a Friday Audition is possible)

You will all read from the same script with another student. Be prepared to read either part with a friend or we will pair you with someone. All auditioning for a singing role must sing.

How will we audition?

- 1. You will need to come to auditions *only* if you are auditioning for a speaking part. Come right away after school and be ready. **There is no chorus on audition or "call back" day**. If you are not auditioning, then go directly home that week.
- 2. Be prepared to read the script that you chose. Show your stuff!
- 3. You will also need to sing a short (**45 seconds**) song without CD or piano. You pick the song. "A Brave New World" or "Friend like Me" would be good choices. Sing "Row Row Row your Boat" or "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star" if you don't know what to sing.
- 4. A panel of judges will listen to your audition and song (if singing).
- 5. A callback list will be posted on the music room door, by Monday Jan. 16th. I will also email the list if you give me an email.

Call backs will be on Tuesday, Jan. 24th after school in the music room. Regular play practice begins on January 31st with the first Thursday rehearsal on February 2nd.

- 7. A Cast list will be posted after we decide roles.
- 8. If you want to be in the chorus or a townsperson, you do not need to audition. You do have to provide your own costume, come to rehearsals and be on your **best** behavior.

Be expressive, speak with a loud voice, look at the judges, and show you can be a star!
